Canvas: Speed Grading. One-Line Writing

- A. **Goal:** As a literacy course, students must write. To be a scalable course, grading must be quick.
- B. **Objective:** Grading one-line writing should require *less than 30 seconds per student question*. Thus an assignment with two questions in a class with 50 students should take no more than 50 minutes.
- C. **Grading Rubric.** To achieve that time requires the use of grading rubrics that are simple and student tested.

X3-AW Question 1

Q1:

- 1: Did not include 'net electricity'
- 1: Did not include 'generation', 'production' or equivalent.
- 1: Included test or base rankings.
- 1: Wrong direction. Spain ranked higher than Australia
- 1: Gave a difference comparison (ranked 2 places higher). Violates rules.
- 1: Formed a ratio comparison on ranks. Invalid. 2nd place is not half of 1st.
- 1: Did not write an ordered comparison.
- 1: Did not compare Spain and Australia.
- 1: Did not include the year
- 1: Used 'compared to' or 'relative to' in place of than. Non-parallel structure.
- 0: Ranks are not smaller/larger; they are higher/lower.
- 0: Wrote more than one sentence
