Canvas: Select Grades; Select 'Gear'

Gradebook handles late submissions two ways:

- Enter a null value: a value not included in total grade
- Enter a zero for assignments not posted by the due date

The choice is accessed in the Gradebook via the 'gear'.

- Enter 0 for missing Bottom:

Late Submissions: Reasoning

Here is the reasoning behind these recommendations:

Assignments missing (not yet submitted) after the due date:

• Apply a zero. This is overwritten when a student submits.

Apply deductions to late submissions:

- 10% per day deducted from grade
- 50% is lowest possible grade.
 Students have an incentive to submit no matter how late.
 Late submitters get higher grades than non-submitters.

Potential Problems Applying Late Zero Policy

Changing this is best done in setup after the course due dates are entered before students have submitted anything.

Changing can be **problematic** during the course for an assignment where the due date is past, students have already submitted and the due date is changed to a future date.

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


Check with your IT technical support, search the web and talk to your colleagues.

Bottom line: Handle this during the setup.


Occasionally this feature is turned off during an import. So always double check before the course starts.

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
