If you want a permanent copy, buy a paper copy.

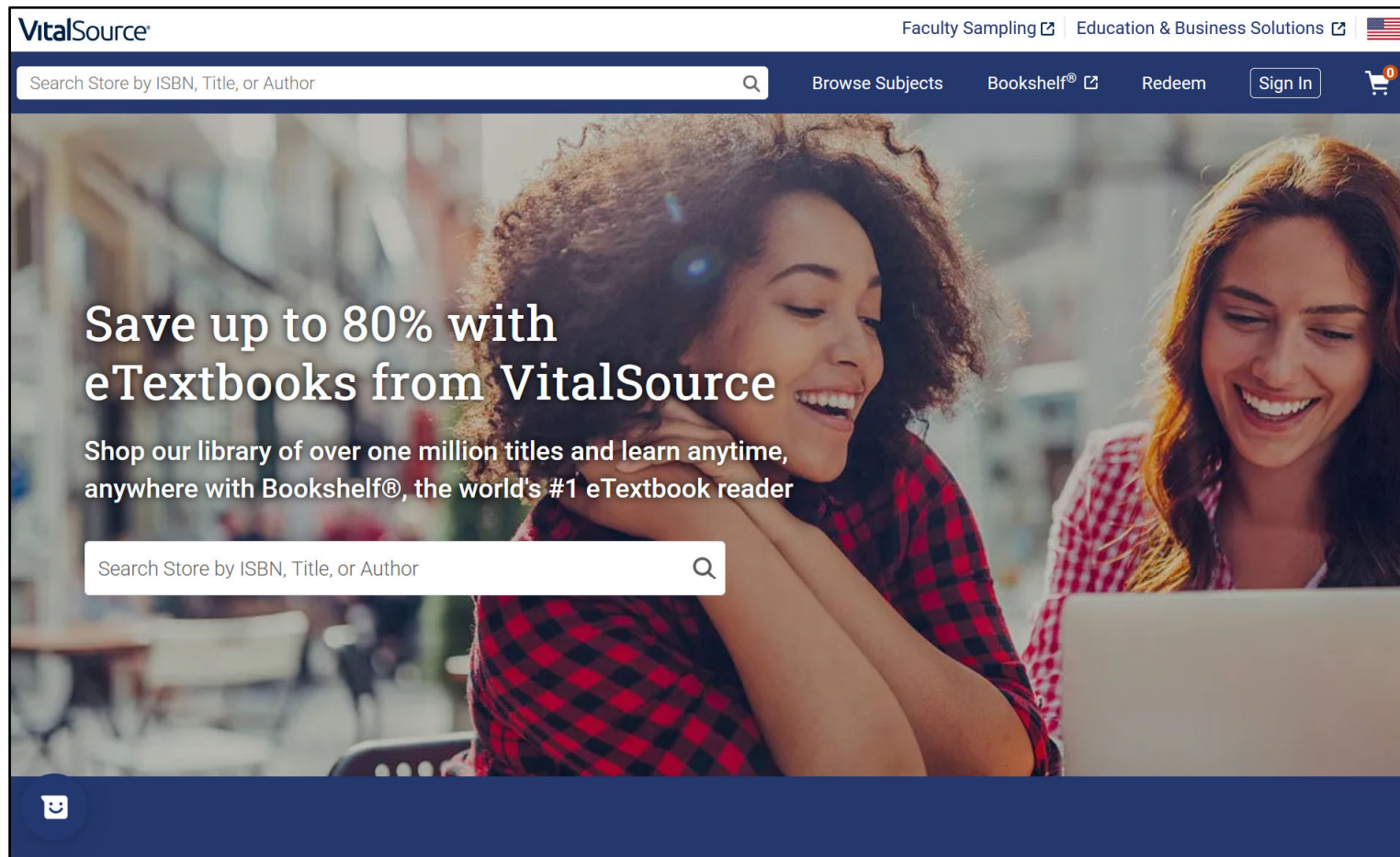
Digital codes: Get from Kendall-Hunt or your bookstore.

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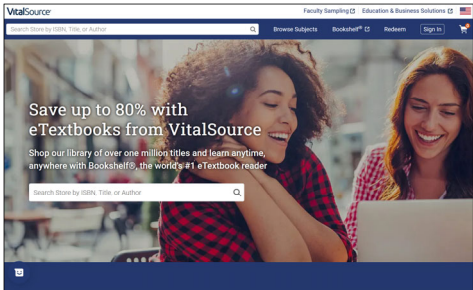

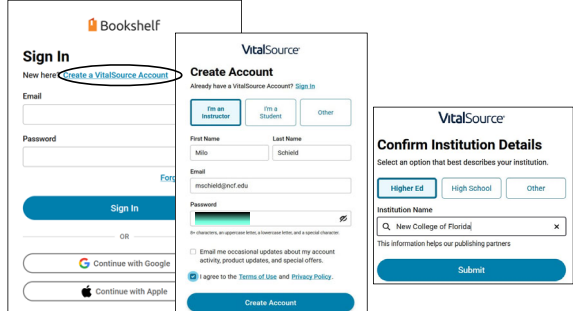
